Stephanie Bosch studied first recorder and baroque transverse flute in Cologne/Wuppertal as well as in Rotterdam where she post graduated in 2002 with distinction. Numerous master classes complemented her professional training. She is the founder of the Baroque chamber music Ensemble „**La Gioia Köln**“ as well as playing baroque transverse flute with different Baroque Orchestras.

By lucky coincidence she discovered the north Indian flute Bansuri and became a disciple of **Pandit Hariprasad Chaurasia**, the “living legend” and charismatic Bansuri-Maestro. Fascinated by the sweet sound of the instrument she studied with him in Bombay and Rotterdam and post graduated finally “summa cum laude” at the World Music Department of Rotterdams Conservatory under his guidance in 2007. Additionally she got a scholarship for exceptional artistic qualities.

Stephanie Bosch has performed up to now in Europe, India, Sri Lanka and Pakistan. In addition to a tour in Germany in spring 2007 with 16 concerts, she did interviews and recordings at the WDR for a radio broadcast.

Intensive occupation with “Ancient Music” on one hand and Indian Classical Music on the other hand is influencing each other and forms the characteristic sound of Stephanie Bosch.
